The show will be held at the Harford Technical High School on Sat. October 18th from 10:00 until 5:00 and Sun. October 19th from 11:00 until 4:30. Please be sure that your membership is up to date.

General Rules

1. It is important that all entries be finished at the time of registration and that a photo of each item is attached to the registration form.
2. All bed sized quilts, with the exception of antique quilts, need to have a 4" sleeve attached.
3. Each display object needs to have a label sewn on the back with the owner's name, address, and phone number.
4. It is important that each item submitted be put into a pillow case or cloth bag with your name, address and phone number printed on it.
5. Registration will be held at the August General Membership meeting. The form can be submitted prior to that date by mailing it to:

6. It is understood that each person will work a two hour shift.

Delivery and Pickup

1. Quilts will be accepted from 5:15 to 7:15 on the Friday night, October 17th. They will not be accepted the day of the show.
2. When you deliver the quilt, you will sign in and receive a receipt. PLEASE HANG ON TO YOUR RECEIPT. You will need it to prove the entry is yours.
3. Quilts will be picked up between 5:15 and 5:45. If you are not able to deliver or retrieve your entries during the hours stated, please have someone do it for you. They will also need the receipt.
