

Triangle quilt sleeves by Annette Renard ©

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Cut one rectangle for every 6 inches of top border
Each rectangle should measure 10 inches long by 6 inches wide.

10 Inches



6 inches

Fold rectangle in half along the
long 10 inch edge. Now measures 5"x6"



Sew a quarter inch seam
along the top 5 inch edge



Trim the top corner
by the fold



Rotate the sewn seam 90 degrees
so it is perpendicular to the bottom edge



The triangle should look like this after rotating. Press.



You can press the seam open if you wish



Turn right side out and press



Place raw edge of triangle even with upper raw edge of quilt top. Distribute triangles across top of quilt



Baste to top of quilt, apply binding and finish sewing binding to the back of the quilt including the triangles



Make a small pleat on the top of the sewn triangle just as you would do with a regular quilt sleeve
Tack the tip of the triangle to the back of the quilt



Make sure the pleat does NOT extend beyond the top binding



The resulting triangular quilt sleeve looks like this
